



TERMS & CONDITIONS

PURPOSE

The purpose of the All Hallows Lottery is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the All Hallows Lottery bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing funding for improvement projects, resources, and opportunities for our students.

RULES

1. Each entry is £1 per month (i.e. per draw). Each entry will be allocated a number in order of receipt.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of that month's income;
1st prize – 60% of the prize pot, 2nd prize – 30% of the prize pot, 3rd prize – 10% of the prize pot.
4. All Hallows Lottery is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of All Hallows Catholic School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join (excluding Finance staff members and the Headteacher).
5. Standing Order payments are preferred. All Hallows Lottery tickets are available to be bought individually with cash at the School Finance Office.
6. The draw shall be made in the following month for the preceding month's entries. The winners will be chosen at random, and the draw will be witnessed by at least two finance staff members.
7. Lottery winners will be notified of their prizes within one week of the draw. Prize monies will be transferred by BACS to the same account as the standing order instruction, winning tickets bought with cash will be sent a cheque in the post.
8. Each month's prize winners will be announced on the All Hallows Catholic School website and via All Hallows social media. Announcements may also appear in the News.com newsletters.
9. The All Hallows Lottery will be managed by the Bursar and Headteacher. In case of any dispute the agreed decision of the Bursar and Headteacher is final.
10. If a winner cannot be contacted; after six months the winnings will be added to funds raised to support the school for improvement projects, resources, and opportunities for our students.
